A Sad Christmas for Ireland



Just 7 months from the removal of constitutional protection for the unborn children of Ireland, the politicians have already passed a permissive abortion law, cruelly refusing even to ensure pain relief for babies killed in late term abortions. For this reason procuring an abortion incurs automatic excommunication.
