**ANNUAL MASS FOR THE DEAD**



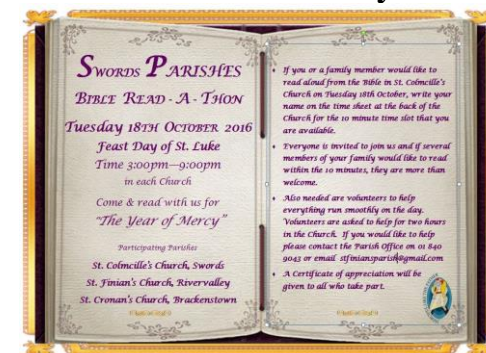
